

PALINDROMES DEFINED

-Palindromes are words or phrases that read the same in both directions, e.g. EYE, or RACECAR, or MADAM I'M ADAM.

EXAMPLES:

- Do geese see God?
- Was it Eliot's toilet I saw?
- Murder for a jar of red rum.
- Some men interpret nine memos.
- Never odd or even.
