
Head Perspective Chart

Greetings, fellow artists! This is just a quick little chart of a few heads drawn from different angles. I'm not a professional and did not use any reference for this so there are some mistakes down there, but I believe it will be of some help to beginners who want to practice drawing heads. :D

The light blue lines give an approximation of where each facial feature should go, but not necessarily. Draw what you think looks right, not what matches the lines. The heads belong to a random character. Some features, such as the hair length, vary between heads to ensure no essential details are blocked.



Tips on practicing:

Draw everyday. If you're a beginner, it's good to copy (but don't trace) other drawings or photographs. Be sure to ask the original artists for permission before posting your copied art anywhere. You don't need permission to simply copy for the sake of practicing as long as you keep it to yourself and never show it off.

If you want to draw something from your mind's eye without reference, you must first copy it at least 5-10 times everyday. Then try to draw it without reference, afterwards, look at a reference to correct any mistakes. Eventually, the fundamental aspects of the image will be etched into your mind in 3D and you'll be able to draw without any reference.
