Most of the people are symptomless, others may experience:

- SEVERE HEADACHE
- SHORTNESS OF BREATH
- NOSEBLEED
- SEVERE ANXIETY
- FEELING OF PULSATIONS IN THE NECK OR HEAD

COMPLICATIONS

After a prolonged period, untreated high blood pressure can cause heart disease and related complications such as heart attack, stroke, and heart failure.

Other complications include:

- FLUID BUILD UP IN THE LUNGS
- VISION LOSS
- KIDNEY DAMAGE
- ERECTILE DYSFUNCTION
